Commissioner Gulbert said "yes" as long as they ask the Chief first. The Chief is to contact the Board to let them know whether it is a "yes" or "no."

<u>Insurance</u> – Commissioner Caronia reported that divers are covered fully by the Board's insurance. He reported that the Zodiak and wave runners are covered under the Board's policy, as well.
