Chief Bonfonti reported that the mounting system is not for the new truck 7201; they are having a problem with the charger for 7201. He reported that the deck gun on 7201 does not raise up high enough; it needs to be jacked up 4". Chief Bonfonti reported that the Zodiac is not holding air; the trailer is falling apart; they want to take the Zodiac out of service; it has proved to be unreliable. He reported that they can accomplish the same tasks with the jet ski. Chief Bonfonti reported that the winch for the jet sky trailer has to be replaced. He said that he will check with the Coast Guard to see if they can use jet skis at night. Chief Bonfonti asked what the Board wanted to do with the Zodiac (sell?). Chief Bonfonti reported that the thermal imaging camera is to go out for repair. He reported that some firefighters are interested in going to FDIC @ \$700 per person.

- 7. Due to issues with the middle bay door closing on its own. 7201 and 05 are switched. Please be sure you clear the door before transmitting as this may be the cause of the problem. Hopefully the new procedures will prevent another mishap.
- We are dealing with a pager shortage. The Fire Company put funds aside for the purchase of new pagers.
