**For the month of May we responded to 10 calls bringing the yearly total to 58.**

1. 7201 mounting of the TIC and CO meter are complete. The truck will be leaving on June 26<sup>th</sup> for the deck gun modifications.
2. Tarp pins on 7201 and Holmatro tool strap need to be added.
3. 7207 Back-up alarm is repaired. Air bottles on 7207 need to be hydro tested and the wash down is in need of repair.
4. Cascade is repaired and 100% operational.
5. Holmatro tool is out for routine service and repair due to a fuel leak. We have a loaner while repairs are being made.
6. At this time no delivery date has been given on the new Explorers.
7. All Marine vehicles we are in need of PFD's (quote attached). Various other items were purchased by the Fire Company.
8. Fit Testing has been completed.
9. Hose and Ladder testing are scheduled for late August.
10. Quotes are in to outfit the new 7200 and 7210 with lights and control boxes. We are still waiting for an answer from the DPW if they can do the vehicle wrap.
11. 7237 has a bad circuit board that is causing the low pressure alarm. We are attempting to locate a replacement board. This does not affect the trucks operation at all.
12. We would suggest the Commission consider selling the rescue dummy and Jon-boat.
