Adoption of Temporary Budget 2018

WHEREAS, it has become necessary for the Commissioners of Fire District No. 2 in the Township of Little Egg Harbor, County of Ocean, by resolution, to adopt a temporary budget to make appropriations and to provide for the period between the beginning of the fiscal year, January 1, 2018, and the adoption of the budget by the legal voters of the fire district, which election is scheduled for February 17, 2018.

(1) A temporary budget is hereby adopted to be effective from the beginning of the fiscal year as noted above and to be in full force and effect until the adoption of the annual fire district budget as referenced above; the total of the appropriations of the temporary budget to reflect not in excess of 14% of the total of the appropriations made for all purposes in the budget for the preceding fiscal year exclusive of appropriations for interest and debt redemption charges and capital improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District at an open public meeting held on January 2, 2018 that the Annual Budget of the Fire District for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2018 and ending December 31, 2018, is hereby adopted and, [subject to the proposed referendum being approved by 50 percent of the voters] shall constitute appropriations for the purposes stated and authorization of Total Revenues of \$716,186, which includes amount to be raised by taxation of \$619,686, and Total Appropriations of \$716,186; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Annual Budget as presented for adoption reflects each item of revenue and appropriation in the same amount and title as set forth in the introduced and approved budget, including all amendments thereto, if any, which have been approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that an annual election shall be held on the third Saturday of February to determine the amount to be raised by taxation for the ensuing year. The results of which shall be subsequently certified to the Division and the Municipal Assessor.
