Shall the Commissioners of Fire District No. 2, in the Township of Little Egg Harbor, County of Ocean be authorized to expend not in excess of \$175,000.00 for the purchase of SCBA equipment?

A notice of said meeting with be published 10 day prior to the election in the Asbury Park Press and the Press of Atlantic City. A notice will always be posted at 5 locations in town.

April the Fire Company responded to 17 calls for a total of 46 calls to date.

- 1. 7227 the batteries in 7227 have been replaced and the vehicle is operating normally.
- 2. The Jon Boat painting is completed and lettering is next for all the vehicles. I will get ideas and quotes to present at a later date.
- 3. Attached is a quote for all the emergency lighting / scene lighting for 7237. This is a priority request for the safety of the freighters and public.
- 4. I am requesting the funds for two (2) work boxes and an outboard motor mount for the bed of 7217 not to exceed thirteen hundred dollars (\$1300.00) for all items. I am also requesting we look at options to fabricate a rack on the ski trailer to transport the Jon Boat.
- 5. 7227 has the batteries replaced by public works and the vehicle is running normally.
- 7200 and 7210 keep having a problem with the batteries dying after 2 or 3 days of not being started. We are looking at some different options to avoid this from happening.
